**TAL Cards, reciprocal cards and Interlibrary Loan** — access the collections of libraries from across the province

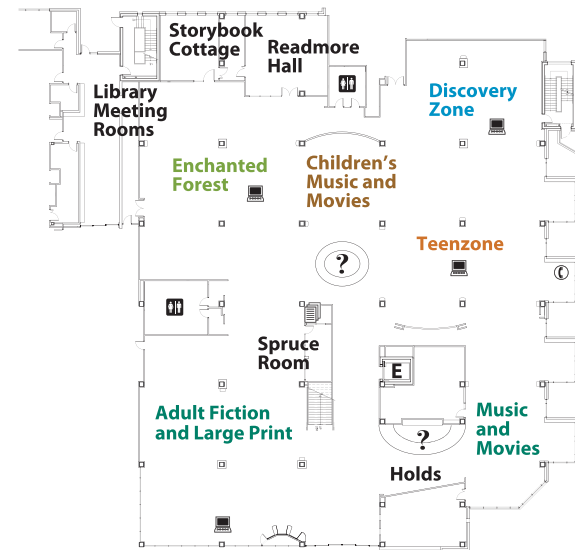

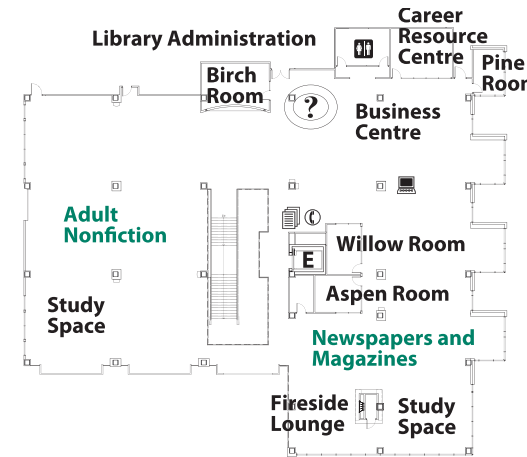

**Small rooms, fireplace lounge and study spaces** — quiet space to read or study and areas to relax and visit
